The session will consist of professional studio artists creating and collaborating with students on open-ended projects using a variety of mediums. The projects will utilize both traditional and non-traditional materials in staging/studio areas in front and around the BCGG building. We will explore everything from drawing, painting, sculpture, installation art, murals, stained glass windows, found object creations, photography, video and Social Practice art. We will take an interdisciplinary approach to art that will connect to student's academic classes, personal interests and art history. The outdoor work areas will be seen as a working collaborative art studio. Our goal is to capture a student's attention and spark a desire to learn and do more.
