AVID23 alumni took time out of their busy summer schedules to participate in six workshops to prepare for the transition to college in the fall. We are grateful to the United Way of Greenwich and the Fairfield County's Community Foundation for their generous grants to fund programming and to the YMCA of Greenwich for providing a beautiful space for learning and laughter.

Trish Rohr, AVID SUCCESS Program Director and educator, provided insights on academic success on campus, organizing time, tasks & materials, the magic of a to-do list and the importance of utilizing campus resources. Students spent time familiarizing themselves with their specific college's information and services so they can hit the ground running! AVID Alumni shared experiences and stories from their time as college students, and Nancy Kail taught personal finance and paying for college strategies. The Greenwich Department of Health presented tips on staying safe on campus and gave guidelines for healthy nutritional habits. Community partner & Alliance supporter, Michael Chambers of the Heidenreich Foundation, entertained with his stories while inviting the students to put his contact in their phones as a future resource. The sessions culminated with Board Member and Coach Ivonne Zucco's conversation with AVID parents about family adjustments to having a college student. Her facilitated discussion in Spanish led to a vibrant session that addressed many questions and concerns.
